THIS HOUSE WAS DESIGNED FOR A BUSINESSMAN AND HIS FAMILY. THIS HOUSE'S PIECE OF LAND IS IN A VERY CROWDED AREA OF OSAKA PREFECTURE. SO SECURITY WAS AN IMPORTANT CONSIDERATION WHEN DESIGNING THIS RESIDENCE. SHUTTING OUT DANGER WHILE LETTING IN LIGHT WAS THE CHALLENGE. THIS HOUSE IS SURROUNDED BY A THICK AND HIGH RC WALL, BUT THERE IS A COURTYARD INSIDE THE WALL. LIVING ROOM FACES THE COURT THROUGH THE 4.5 METER-HIGH WINDOW. AN 8M-LONG TOP LIGHT IN THE BACK OF THE LIVING ROOM ENSURES THAT ENOUGH LIGHT COMES INTO THE AREA WHERE THE FAMILY SPENDS IT SPECIAL TIME.
